GOD'S MIGHTY WARRIORS OF GORDONVALE

Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being certain of what we do not see. That is what the people of long ago were praised for" (Heb 11:1-3).

Along with many others at schools across Cairns, we at Gordonvale Primary have been given the mighty privilege of bringing God's love and His word to these precious children in this fallen and hurting world. Remembering that "to whom much is given, much will be required" (Luke 12:48), we seek the will of the Holy Spirit in preparation of lessons; praying for the children, their families, the teachers and us, the RE teachers.

While we have to follow a curriculum to produce the lesson aim and learning outcomes, we can have lots of fun bringing variety to the lessons.

"But understand this, in the last days there will come times of stress. Men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, inhuman, ...lovers of pleasure rather than lov-

ers of God," (2 Tim 3:1-5). Sadly we see many children who are abused, whether emotionally, physically, mentally, sexually; it is tragic to see their hurting little faces. However, we have been given this wonderful opportunity to bring to the children God's plan for us all to be friends with Him through Jesus. Disruptions come, not only from some of the children, but also teachers, cutting into our lesson times, keeping children from class by giving them something else to do. Some teachers are not supportive of scripture. However, when many of the children run up to me with a huge smile and a hug, it's as though Jesus is giving me a hug; I know God is indeed working in their lives.

After classes we get together for a cup of tea; to talk about how the lessons went; have a prayer time to thank God, pray for specific children, issues, the school, the parents.

It is essential to pray God's word. "In all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us." (Rom 8:37).

"How beautiful are the feet of those who preach good news!" (Rom 10:14-17). "...Let us run with perseverance the race set before us," (Heb 12 1-3). "...Put on the whole armour of God, ..." (Eph 6:10-18). "Do not be afraid, the Lord your God himself will fight for you". (Deut 3:22). We see the spiritual battle going on in the classrooms, so I ask that many of you pray for these children who are being prepared for GOD'S MIGHTY WARRIORS OF GORDONVALE.

Let us be among those who "keep watch", like the "ten virgins" the "good and faithful servant" (Matt 24:36- 51 and Matt 25:1-30).

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope. (Rom15:13).

Mens' Ministry

Men let's take these three words as points of focus for us this year –

Truth, Power and Purpose.

Truth. The early gold miners quickly learned that not everything that looked like gold actually was. If they weren't sure what they had found was genuine they developed tests like scratching it on a white ceramic dish. True gold left a yellow streak. Men we need to equip ourselves to be discerning. In First Thessalonians 5.21-22 Paul tells us to "test everything; hold fast to what is good. Abstain from every form of evil." We are not told to judge other

peoples thoughts and motives – that's God's business – but we are called to discriminate and judge good from evil, right from wrong, truth and error. So what is truth? Paul says again to the Thessalonians "stand firm and hold to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by our spoken word or by our letter." (2 Thess 2.15). He is urging them and us blokes, to use the written Word of God, the Bible, as the only reliable "ceramic dish" to determine truth. How often do you open the covers of this amazing

book? How regularly do you expose yourself to the very words of God, the instrument of the Holy Spirit? Men, for us to live a life of integrity and lead in His Power and for His Purposes we need to grow in our knowledge of Him who has saved us.

Mischa Grummitt

Mischa Grummitt, 22, is a school chaplain for Barkly Highway and Spinifex State College junior and senior campuses in Mt Isa.

Mischa admits the job was challenging "There are a lot of issues to deal with such as drinking, drugs, family problems and homelessness.

"I show the students that someone is out there to help them and that they don't have to do destructive stuff."

He runs breakfast and lunch programs, helps with social skills and offers support to other staff.

However, his main focus was on the

students who needed a positive role model in their lives.

His dedication does not go unnoticed; during the recent school holidays, he was congratulated by Mount Isa police for keeping kids off the streets and in social programs.

It is an occupation that demands patience and a deep sense of commitment to individuals who are often searching for a role model. Mischa was fortunate in that his role models were close to home and they taught him the valuable lessons he would later need to pass on to others.

His parents were instrumental in their influence on a young Mischa who grew up in Cairns.

It was a

childhood rich with love.

In 2005, he moved to Mount Isa to take on the role of student support worker at the Spinifex Residential College.

"Once I got established with the Isa Community Church, I felt more a part of the family there and I had people to talk with and hang out with."

In 2007, he took a leap of faith and applied for the position of school chaplain "My whole life, I thought I would like to be a chaplain. We had one in my school and they had a positive influence on the students.

"I don't know how I can make such a difference in their lives without being a chaplain. The students can relate to me."

With his parents' support, Mischa said he would like to continue being a chaplain which may lead to social work or counselling someday, but right now he has one more task to tackle.

"I am getting married in October to Jess Whyte, a girl I met at church. Mount Isa will definitely be home for some time to come."

"Chaplaincy is not a nine to five job. You are never not a chaplain. You never hang it up."

Penny will be spending her time with some of these children, loving them and being involved in their schoolwork. She really doesn't know how this will all pan out, but on her return will be very keen to share her incredible experiences. Please remember this mission during your prayers this month.
