# Rebuilding the family



**W**hen Nehemiah heard the report from his family that his beloved city and people were in ruins his heart was broken by the brokenness of his people and his city. The city walls, which were in ruin, were significant for the people's identity, security, and significance. For as long as the walls remained in ruins so too did the identity, security and significance of the family of Israel.

Families are a gift from God. For God designed the family unit to be a place where we learn and experience in a tangible way the intimate love of our Heavenly Father. In the intimacy of God birthed families we discover our true identity, security and significance reflected in our relationships with one another and our Father.

When the family is broken so too are we. When we are broken so too is the

family. Brokenness is a vicious cycle that requires faith-filled, courageous, and determined people willing as Nehemiah was to face their brokenness and take it to the king.

The king resourced Nehemiah with everything he needed to overcome the brokenness in Nehemiah's family. All that was required was for people to embrace, accept and put into use all that the king supplied. The kings supply did not negate hard, committed, and courageous work on behalf of the people, but it was impossible for the people to rebuild the wall without the kings provision.

We don't have to look too far or intently to see the effects of broken families; it is all around us and even within us. BUT we have a king who is ready to supply all we need to rebuild the family the way God intended.

**"17 Then I said to them, "You see the trouble we**

**are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace." 18 I also told them about the gracious hand of my God upon me and what the king had said to me. They replied, "Let us start rebuilding." So they began this good work. Nehemiah 2:17-18 (NIV84)**

Come let us rebuild.... the gracious hand of God is upon us.
