My Testimony

In the last few years there has been lots and lots of turmoil in my life and home. Both my parents died, my marriage went through a very difficult time where I actually moved out with 6 of the children and everything was in chaos.

I knew I should be going to church but I always had an excuse not to go. It wasn't until this year when I got to know Rosemary through Geckos that I started coming to church and I just knew that this was the right place to be. I started coming along to the coffee group during Geckos and met ladies and then I met Jennifer too. I remember telling her how I was so depressed only a few weeks ago but suddenly I was feeling so light and like I didn't have a care in the world. She said to me 'You know you have a lot of people praying for you'. I nearly cried. It was really like someone had come along and picked everything up off my shoulders and carried it away.

After she said that to me I told Rosemary that I wanted to do that bible study she offered and we started doing that together.

I was amazed. Even though I had spent more than 40 years in the Catholic church I never knew what Jesus did for me and that I could have a relationship with Him.

Before we even finished Christianity Explained I knew that Jesus had saved me, I had started talking to Him all the time and asking Him to help me in everything. Now there's not an hour that goes by without me thinking about Him and wondering what He thinks of the decisions I'm making and what I'm doing. I trust Him and if it was my turn to die today I'm not scared anymore. I find it easier to approach life and I have such peace. I know He's got me in His hand and I can see the prayers that He's answered. I now prefer to hang out with my Christian friends and my desires have changed because God has changed me. I go to a lifegroup with other Christian ladies on Monday mornings and am learning more.

I'm so happy that my 14 year old daughter is also



following my example. She goes to Youth Group and is making such good choices. I'm so proud of her, when I compare her to her 14 year old cousin who is smoking, drinking and sleeping with her boyfriend in her own mother's house. She is wanting to be pure, is staying in school and having good friends. We are able to talk about God things together, which is so amazing. I'm praying that the younger ones will also find it easier to grow up knowing God because of what's happened to me. Please pray for my other daughter, older boys and my husband. It would be SO nice to see a turnaround in their lives and especially in my husband's life. It would affect our family so massively.

- 30 mins of 'church' learning about the God who created, loved and sacrificed ... all for those kids who have 'ants in their pants'!
- 30 mins of church – for the classroom teacher!
- 30 mins of loving ... when the classroom teacher is away, and the children have a relief teacher ... loving through the power of God's Spirit ... connecting when no one else can!
- 30 mins of celebrating ... 20 out of 23 year 2 children coming to Christ!! Mimicking the party in heaven with cake, food, gifts and singing!
- 30 mins of obedience - for revival for Cairns through the kids
- 30 mins of equipping the children – enabling transformed lives
- 30 mins of humility – not always having the answers!
- 30 mins of impacting kids for life - long after they're grown up and having kids of their own
- 30 mins of Heaven in schools, across the city each week
- 30 mins of being surprised by God!

Who would want to miss out on that!



As coordinator of the Kids Hope Mentoring program that we run at Edge Hill School I get to see some great and beautiful things. Just last week I was near the school office when one of our Kids Hope kids came to me and asked “Mrs Cossa is Phil coming today?” It was the first week back at school and he knew it was his day and almost time for his mentoring hour. We chatted a bit- and all of a sudden a huge smile came over his whole face and I knew it wasn’t directed at me – our conversation was over and he was off – it was

my turn then for a huge grin (& a tear or two!) as I watched him run up to his mentor – they enthusiastically shook hands but that obviously wasn’t enough, he then threw his arms around Phil! Does Phil’s hour with this child each week make a difference to his life? ABSOLUTELY- to both of them don’t you think? What an amazing opportunity to demonstrate the love and faithfulness of our Father to children who may not have it so great at home for whatever reason and may not otherwise benefit from one-to-one time spent with a caring adult. We currently have 10

mentors – 8 ladies and 2 men. At present we only have one girl being mentored – all the others are boys. We obviously have a real need for Godly men to consider becoming involved- to be a good male role model and friend in a young boy’s life. If you think you’d like to know more, I’d love to talk to you and I’m sure our male mentors Phil and Nathan would be happy to chat and share from their experiences as well.

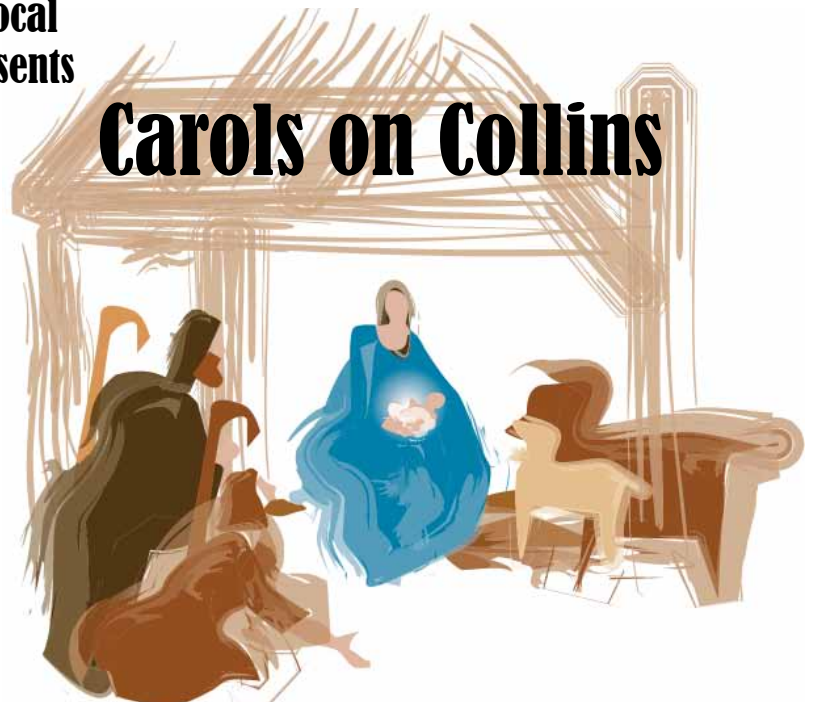

NORTHERN INDIA – Jossy Chacko, EMPART

(Below is information taken or extracted from their October 2010 newsletter)

The mustard seed is a tiny seed that produces big results. Empart's ministry is just like that mustard seed. Their Church Planters enter a community, get involved and begin sowing seeds of hope. They work to grow, influence and transform entire communities through the Gospel message.

You may recall that earlier in the year, EMPART's

Men's and Women's Training Centres in Durg were forced to move locations due to anti-Christian activists storming the premises and interrogating their students and leaders about their activities. The Training Centres have since been moved to another location but the danger of another attack remains. Despite the dangers, their future Church Planters and Key Women are determined to continue their studies and outreach work so they can transform lives and impact their communities with the love of Christ.

In August this year they are pleased to report they witnessed a record number of baptism - 1144!! Praise God for His faithfulness – not to mention encouragement for us here in beautiful Cairns!!

GHANA:

Letter from Tim and Shell Hickin, African Christian Homes & Rehabilitation Centre

To our family in Christ, Just a quick note to let you know how things are going in Ghana with African Christian Homes & Rehabilitation Centre.

The shipping container has been delivered! Our contact here, Rev. Kofi Boateng was in Ghana to meet the container & personally deliver the computers, and now a computer training centre is up & running in Tanoso, near Kumasi. The program is running from a school that Kofi's late father built. The vast majority of people in the village have never seen a computer.

The impact the centre is having, and will have on the community is far reaching, as the computers not only provide training in IT but access to much needed educational literature for the whole school.

'Centre for Change'**

"Thank you Centenary Lakes for your wonderful support over this year, and for wanting to know the significant happenings at Center For Change. The most significant event for myself in 2010 was a fresh revelation of the fact that "it is not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit", says the Lord. And how exciting to see God at work in our midst by His Spirit during our regular mid-week prayer meeting. What a sight to see young people on their knees, or standing and weeping and crying out to God. To be honest we didn't know what was going on, until testimony time, when we understood that our young people were having their own encounter with God. Some even heard their name called by God, and heard Him say, "your sins are forgiven". Since that time our prayer meetings have become more focused in that we not only pray for all our supporters in Australia, but give time to pray for the families of our young people, whether we know where they are

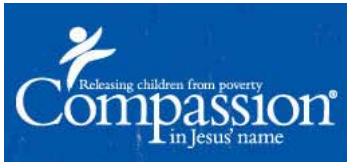
or not. The constant cry is that they also might come to know Jesus. Soon after that prayer meeting we began to focus on reaching out to the families of our kids as best we could on Sundays, which has resulted in some family members becoming constant in fellowship, and others making sound commitments of their lives to the Lord. Watching 26 young people, mothers, grandmothers and one father following the Lord through the waters of baptism was certainly a memorable occasion. It is also encouraging to recognize that street people and street children have confidence to join with us during our Sunday worship. Our first three students at College has brought great joy as we consider eight years ago they were surviving the best they could on the streets. And as of September 21, we have 88 children and youth in our care (it could be 89 tomorrow). God has brought us a long way by His grace, and we continue expectant at what He has ahead. We fully expect to be baking our own bread in our own bakery by the end of this year, and recognize

that this is one step closer to sustainability of this ministry. We acknowledge that Center For Change is blessed and continuing to press toward the mark of our high calling, because of God's amazing grace, enabling and equipping the most ordinary of His people who have made themselves available to be used of Him in the most extraordinary event of seeing young lives transformed from glory to glory. Thank you Centenary Lakes Church of Christ for being a part with us in seeing more and more young people and older ones as well, given a hope and a future with a solid foundation built on Christ.
