## MIG - Connect3e

*"Most of us won't die from land-mines, malaria, dengue fever, malnourishment, or TB. We won't be stopped at checkpoints, jailed, raped, beaten, shot at, or have our homes and crops burnt."*

*Phil Thornton. Restless Souls; Rebels, Refugees, Medics and Misfits on the Thai/Burma Border*

### **For the Karen people of Burma this IS their reality.**

Centenary Lakes Christian Community are committed to changing this reality through our partnership with Connect3e. Connect3e is an organisation founded by an Australian family as their response to the plight of the Karen refugees. Connect3e's mission is to embrace, educate and empower the Karen refugees that have fled Burma (Myanmar) and now live in Thailand along the Thai/Burma border. Years of ongoing violence in Burma has disrupted most if

not all of the Karen refugees' education. Once in Thailand, it is often difficult to access education - due to positional inaccessibility, limited ID or lack of finances.



University Students

Connect3e education assistance projects begin at pre-school and continue through to tertiary. One project offers scholarships (\$1,200 AUD) to young Karen students hoping to pursue a higher education. The scholarship in most cases covers the entire amount of fees, books, stationery and uniforms for that year. Students must earn money to cover their own food and accommodation; this allows them to retain their dignity and gives

a sense of ownership.

Education is paramount in enabling people to develop as God intended because it expands their ability to think, to learn and to question. By providing the funds for one of these scholarships Centenary Lakes Christian Community will give a student hope for their future, provide them with possibilities, where previously they had none, and give them a choice. This scholarship will alter the trajectory of a student's life. Connect3e's greatest desire is to be part of the re-empowerment of the Karen; to see current and future generations led by their own people, in their own language and within their own culture.

# Reflections On Pastoral Care

This year has proved to be one of the most significant in my life. I believe I am functioning in an area of ministry that suits my heart and calling. One key area of ministry is pastoral care, and it has been my privilege to look, listen and learn about this area as well as to practice the love of God in community. I would like to briefly comment on two ideas that are critical to effective pastoral care in our community; **care and compassion.**

**Caring** for people is one of the greatest expressions of love. I enjoy seeing the care a parent or carer gives to children or people. I enjoy deep hugs with my boys. They relish them and I find great contentment and satisfaction. Similarly, a shepherd with a caring heart looks out for the sheep, protecting, guiding and providing for their needs. Last week I heard this phrase that I believe was God-inspired – **to care be aware.**

In a smaller group context, like a lifegroup, being aware of one another's wellbeing and responding appropriately is the essence of good caring. Caring involves good communication and follow up to particular needs. There may be physical or practical needs that could be addressed – making a meal, mowing someone's lawn or visiting someone who is alone. There are spiritual practices too. Praying for people battling illness, experiencing financial stress or life pressures is so valuable and effective. The word **compassion**, meaning to suffer together with, is a standout quality that Christ exhibited. This idea denotes a strong degree of empathy. Jesus felt things. Being not only fully God, but also fully human, He experienced the full range of human emotions and pains. When a suffering woman (in Mark 5) reached out and touched His garment, Jesus felt power being released from

His person. He looked around to find the person. The woman felt ashamed but Jesus affirmed her faith and reassured her of her healing. At Calvary, the site of His great passion, Jesus experienced overwhelming pain and suffering. However, as Hebrews 12:2 states that **for the joy set before Him, Jesus endured the cross.** Jesus was willing to endure the cross not for Himself, but for us. We are the prize that he so eagerly wanted. His suffering had the greatest significance; restored fellowship for us with the Godhead. It is a joy to care and serve in our precious community. Let us look out, care, feel and respond to the issues that present. Jesus the Good Shepherd watches over us and the Holy Spirit is with us in His kingdom endeavours.
