# Rest

**A**re you getting enough? What tires you out most? Why do some people get more tired than others? Are there different kinds of tiredness?

Some tiredness we just can't avoid, it is part of normal living, but I can't help but think much of the tiredness we experience is self inflicted tiredness. We carry things we were not meant to carry? We don't let go of things we know we need to let go of. We try and control things we really have no control over. And all the while Jesus is inviting us to a place of rest.

**“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” (Matthew 11:28–30, NIV)**

Notice the invitation is to let go of what we are carrying

and to take Jesus yoke on us. We find this so hard. It challenges our need to be in control and the boss. It challenges our need to be self sufficient and self reliant. It is an invitation to rest in the area we need to rest most – at a soul level.

This is not a new invitation. God spoke the same invitation over the nation of Israel

**“ This is what the Sovereign LORD, the Holy One of Israel, says: “In repentance and rest is your salvation, in quietness and trust is your strength,. ” (Isaiah 30:15, NIV)**

God does not intend for us to live consistently tired and burnt out. It is not a good look as it reflects poorly on who God is and His nature.

**“ Do you not know? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can**

**fathom. He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak. Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. ” (Isaiah 40:28–31, NIV)**

Maybe you need to get some sleep. Maybe, just maybe you need to rest in front of the TV. But this I know we need rest at a soul level and it is the one rest God constantly invites us to. Why not RSVP to Him today and make a regular date to rest in Him

**M**IG this month are highlighting 2 ladies who work tirelessly in spreading the Word overseas. As a church we support them both! In her latest newsletter Sharlee Young, serving in Asia, shares – Our Father is good at Win-Win Game.

A team from my home church and a local seminary student joined me for two weeks of ministry recently.

In the community centre out in the west, we conducted seminars on various topics including marriage, trauma and caring for babies and elderly. Visitation of building project, earthquake victims and front-line mission workers who told numerous moving testimonies, all kept our days occupied intensely. In the face of difficult circumstances these people's perseverance and trust in the Lord encouraged our team greatly. Each team member was gifted in different areas and used in different settings.

Here is an extract from her newsletter –

**What a sight to see twenty-six following the Lord through the waters of baptism! Wow, what a Sunday. It has been wonderful talking to our youth about their experiences of surrendering all as they went down under the water, or feeling God's love all around them and hearing their sincere expressions to live for God. Also it was especially precious to hear one of the grandmothers testify what a difference Jesus has made in her life, and regardless of the negative responses of those in her village at her commitment to Christ, there is no turning back for her because Jesus has made the difference in her life. "He who began a good work in them will carry it on to completion".**

At our latest MIG meeting we decided we would like to offer Margaret a donation, which grew into inviting the whole

church to fundraise for the month of September and dedicate the funds to this cause. We asked Margaret's opinion. This was her reply –

How wonderful! How about Christmas gifts for the Kids Club members? Last year we had 500 at the Christmas party, this year we are still building up numbers, of course come Christmas there will be a sudden influx of children who know there will be a party and gift. Then we would prioritise those regular attendees and perhaps a small token gift for other children. What do you think of that idea? It's too costly to send boxes from Cairns, but we can buy gifts here locally. Perhaps you could aim for 300 gifts of \$5. Is that the kind of project you are thinking of?

So we are presenting this to you all –these are kids from the squatter area who have absolutely nothing –so for the month of September, if you would like to donate towards these gifts, please label your extra offering accordingly, or give directly to Mel Pashley or one of the other MIG team members. Margaret also suggested that a photo or card from each donor would be welcome.
